

## Boronia megastigma 'Hot Chocolate'

### FRAGRANT BROWN BORONIA

You don't even have to put your nose into this plant to get a whiff of its amazing fragrance. It's like a combination of gardenias, freesias and citrus. It's a small shrub growing between 3-5 feet wide and tall. Plant in full sun and well drained soil. Even though this is a "Down Under" plant (Australian native), it needs regular water in the summer.



It's not a long lived plant, but you could take cuttings in the late spring, dip them in rooting hormone and then plant them in Perlite. Don't forget to mist them daily.

Boronia generally blooms in the winter months, but this year we have had blooms even in the fall.
