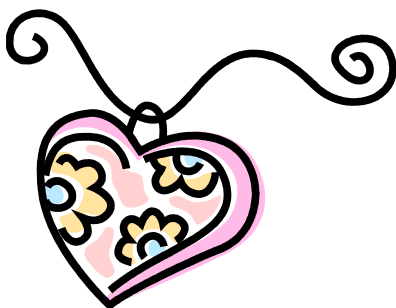

In this workshop you will actually graft your own tree onto a rootstock. This is a hands on class and you will take home a grafted tree. 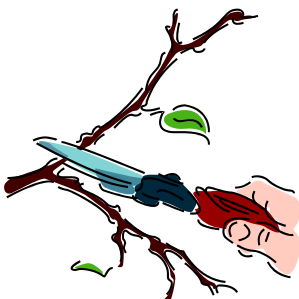
Kid's Valentines Project
